Specialist Bell-Johnson died February 16, 2005, when the military vehicle she was riding in overturned while delivering supplies in Baghdad, Iraq during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Specialist Bell-Johnson, who was serving her second deployment to Iraq, was recognized as an expert shooter and was seeking promotion to Sergeant. She left behind a husband and 1-year old daughter, Gabrielle.
