Jack Wilson opened the meeting and introduced Jim Bannister.

Jim offered the invocation and honored tonight's South Carolina's Fallen Hero, US Army Private First Class Joey T. Sams II, age 22, of Spartanburg, SC; assigned to the 1st BN, 15th Infantry Reg, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 3rd Infantry Division, Ft. Benning, GA.

PFC Sams was killed March 21, 2007, of injuries suffered when he was pinned between two military vehicles in Camp Buehring, Kuwait during Operation Iraqi Freedom.

PFC Sams graduated from Spartanburg High School in 2004, and attended Spartanburg Technical College, studying computer technology. He joined the Army to help him achieve his goal of becoming a police detective. Not all heroes die from bullets and bombs.

Jim then led to assembled group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Jack Wilson then welcomed guests; spoke briefly about Directory Ad sales and encouraged all to seek potential buyers of new listings.
